

Wakenet Membership Agreement

In consideration for the use of the Wakenet Computer System (the "System"), and the efforts of Wakefield Wireless Network Association ("Wakenet") to develop and maintain the System, I understand and agree to the following:

Use of Wakenet is a privilege, which may be revoked.

1. That the use of the System is a privilege, which may be revoked at any time for **failure to pay membership dues**, abusive conduct or fraudulent use. Such conduct would include, but not be limited to, the placing of unlawful information on the system, or violation of this Agreement.

Wakenet may access, view, edit or remove anything, which it feels is unlawful or objectionable.

2. That the Wakenet reserves the right to review any material stored in files or programs to which other Members have access and will edit or remove any material which, in its sole discretion, believes may be unlawful, obscene, abusive, or otherwise objectionable.

Wakenet is NOT liable for losses incurred by your use or non-use of Wakenet.

3. That Wakenet does NOT warrant that the functions of this system will meet any specific requirements I may have; nor that it will be error free or uninterrupted; nor shall it be liable for any indirect, incidental or consequential damages (including lost data, information or profits) sustained or incurred in connection with the use of, operation of, or inability to use the system.

You agree to be bound by rules and regulations set down by Wakenet.

4. To abide by such rules and regulations of system usage as may be set down from time to time by Wakenet.

You release Wakenet, operators, and affiliates for any claims related to the use or non-use of Wakenet.

5. In consideration for the privilege of using Wakenet, I hereby release Wakenet and operators, and any institutions with which they are affiliated, for any and all claims of any nature arising from my use, or inability to use, Wakenet.

You agree to be responsible for your own actions and to compensate anyone harmed by your abusive use of the system.

6. To indemnify Wakenet for any loss suffered to them by reason of my improper use of the System, and to compensate anyone harmed by my abusive use of the system.

Information provided by Wakenet is offered as a community service and NOT as individual professional consultation.

7. That the information provided by Wakenet is offered as a community service and is not a substitute for individual professional consultation. Advice on individual problems should be obtained personally from a professional.

All registered Members of Wakenet must provide accurate and real information on their application.

8. All registered Members of Wakenet must provide accurate information on their application forms. Pseudonyms, nicknames, 'handles' or false names are not allowed -- use your real name. Failure to provide accurate information may result in denial of system access. Willful misrepresentation or deliberate attempts to conceal or forge information may result in legal action against you.

Wakenet prohibits all advertising, except for non-commercial advertisements posted in appropriate news groups.

11. Wakenet prohibits all unsolicited advertising (SPAM), both direct and 'broadcast', except in the case of non-commercial advertisements posted only in the news groups reserved for such purposes.
